PER COURT :-

1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicants.
2. None present for the respondent/acquiring body.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that in the same project, this Court, by order dated 14.07.2023, permitted the applicants/claimants to withdraw 75% of the amount of compensation deposited with proportionate interest. Hence, the order;

- i) The applications are allowed.
- ii) The applicants/claimants are permitted to withdraw 75% of the deposited amount to the extent of their share with proportionate interest on undertaking to the satisfaction of the learned Registrar (Judicial) that they would re-deposit the amount, if the impugned judgments and orders are reversed.
- iii) The remaining amount be kept in fixed deposit receipt in any nationalized bank with renewal clause till final disposal of the appeals.
