PER COURT :-

1. The Petitioner has put forth prayer clause (B) as
under:-

“(B) By way of issuance of appropriate writ, orders or
directions in the like nature, the respondents may please be
directed to pay the remaining professional fees of
Rs.82,375/- (Rupees Eighty Two Thousand Three Hundred
Seventy Five Only) along with interest thereon to the
petitioner.”

2. We are not inclined to issue a Writ of Mandamus for recovering the professional charges of an Advocate.

3. This **Petition is disposed off** with liberty to the Petitioner to avail of a remedy as is permissible in law, including the liberty to approach the competent authority for filing an Appeal.
