ORDER :-

Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned counsel for respondent no.1 - acquiring body and learned AGP for respondent no.2 - State.

2. This is an application seeking directions to the acquiring body to deposit the remaining 50% amount. The applicants/appellants have already withdrawn 50% amount, which was deposited by the acquiring body.

3. Learned counsel for the acquiring body submits that he has no instructions from his client.

4. What is *prima facie* seen is that the amount enhanced is within four times of the amount awarded by the S.L.A.O. We, therefore, direct the acquiring body to deposit the remaining 50% amount in this Court, within six weeks, with accrued interest.

5. The application stands disposed of.
