The petitioner is merely seeking direction to the Waqf Board to undertake an enquiry under Section 40(3) of the Waqf Act, 1995.

The learned advocate Shri Pathan, who appears *suo moto* for Respondent No.5/Waqf Board, on instructions, submits that pursuant to the directions of the Supreme Court of India, the Waqf Board has already undertaken the enquiry and a final decision would be taken not only in respect of other similar institutions, but even in respect of the petitioner and the matter

would be decided within three months.

3. Since the purpose of the petition stands subserved in the light of the above statement, we accept the statement as an undertaking given to the Court and dispose of the Writ Petition.
