**PER COURT :-**

1. The Writ Petition was dismissed for default. By the Civil Application, which is filed with a delay of 216 days, the Applicant prays for the restoration of the Petition. The Respondents opposed the restoration, but submit that if the Petition is restored, the same may be taken up for hearing forthwith.

2. Considering the cause put up in the Petition and the fact that the delay of 216 days is neither deliberate nor inordinate, **the Civil Application is allowed.** The Writ Petition is restored.
