PER COURT:

We have heard the learned advocate Mr. S.V. Dixit for the petitioner and Mr. U.B. Bondar for the respondent No.2 - Zilla Parishad, Latur. They are unanimous that irrespective of the order of remand passed by the Supreme Court in a PIL on the basis of which a crime was registered, a decision was taken by the Chief Executive Officer by order dated 29.02.2024 (**Exhibit-J**) extending all the retiral benefits *inter alia* to the petitioner still those have been stated to be withheld.

2. In view of above, the writ petition is allowed as prayed for. All the retiral benefits payable to the petitioner together with statutory interest, shall be collected and disbursed, as expeditiously as possible and in any case within 90 days.
