PER COURT:

1. The Petitioners have put forth prayer clause (B),
which reads as under :-

"[B] By appropriate writ, order or direction in the like nature of writ, respondents may be directed to decide representations (EXHIBIT A to L) in time bound manner as expeditiously as possible."

Having perused the representations, it appears that the Petitioners have put forth several demands on various grounds, like directions for digital payment to be introduced, removal of encroachment, for nullifying certain conditions of lease agreement, to resort to allotment of plots, to increase the size of plots, lavatory to be installed, etc.
