1. These are the matters of reimbursement of fees in respect of 25% students admitted by the petitioner-management under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.
2. Issue notice to the respondents.
3. Learned AGPs waive service of notice for respondents/State, respectively. Learned Counsel Mr. Bangar, waives service of notice for respondent No.1 in all writ petitions. Learned Counsels Mr. S. R. Dheple, Mr. S. B. Pulkundwar, Mr. A. R. Nikam waive service of notice for respondent No.5 in respective writ petitions.

4. We have heard both sides.

We dispose of the writ petitions by directing the respondents to undertake scrutiny of petitioners' proposals independently on its merit and take appropriate decision, as expeditiously as possible and in any case, within eight (8) weeks from today and if it is found entitled to get reimbursement, shall disburse the amounts to it within four (4) weeks thereafter.
