1. These applications are filed for bringing LR's of deceased appellant No.2 and respondent No.2A, 3A and 3B on record by condoning delay caused in making application to that effect.
2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that there is no intentional delay on the part of the applicants in not bringing LR's of the concerned deceased person on record in time.
3. Learned counsel for the other side opposed the application.
