ORDER :

1. Learned Senior Advocate for applicant submits that in the charge sheet applicant is not arrayed as accused. He however, express apprehension that if during the course of further investigation under section 173(8) of Cr.P.C., applicant is arrayed as accused then he may be given advance notice by the investigating officer.

2. Considering the fact that applicant is not arrayed as accused in the charge sheet, application is disposed of with a direction to the investigating officer to give 72 hours notice to applicant in case applicant is sought to be made accused.
