1. Heard Mr Raunaq Rao for the Applicant.
2. On 10.08.2021, we made the following order in this application:-

“1. Having regard to the antecedents in the matter, it would be expedient that Writ Petition itself is taken up for final hearing.

2. Put up Writ Petition for final hearing on 4.10.2021 along with MCA no. 136 of 2021.”
3. Now that we propose to place the petition for final hearing in the

week commencing from 10.06.2024, there is no need to keep this MCA pending.
