1. Heard Ms Nicole Mayekar for the applicant and Mr Deep Shirodkar, learned Additional Government Advocate for the State.
2. For the reasons set out in the application, though the same is opposed by the learned AGA, in our opinion a case is made out for extending the time to complete the dismantling process of temporary structures in the property surveyed under No.70/14 at Girkarwado, Arambol, Pernem, Goa by a further period of one month in terms of our earlier order dated 19.06.2024.

3. Accordingly, the application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a). After the order is complied with, the respondent no.6 – Goa Coastal Zone Management Authority to file a compliance report.
4. Place the matter for further consideration on 01.10.2024.
