1. It appears from the office note that the Appeal is already restored to its file.
2. This Appeal is filed challenging the judgment and decree passed by learned Joint Civil Judge, Senior Division, satara dated 30.06.2000 in LAR No.17 of 1988, whereby the amount of compensation is enhanced by Rs.4,59,000/-. The SLAO had granted compensation of Rs.1,41,750/-. The amount of difference is Rs.3,17,250/-. Considering the

GR dated 3rd November, 2016 and 11th May, 2018, the amount enhanced is within four times of the amount awarded by learned SLAO. Considering the same, learned AGP seeks leave to withdraw the Appeal.

3. The Appeal stands disposed of as withdrawn.
4. Appellant is entitled to refund of Court fee as per rules.
5. Pending Interim Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
