2 The applicant is one of the sixteen accused, who are being prosecuted for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 409, 417, 420 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 3 and 4 of the Maharashtra Protection of Interest of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Act, 1999.

3 The applicant is a permanent resident of Kaddaddassam, Taluka-Dekkenikota, District-Krishnagiri, Tamil Nadu. At the time of granting bail on 5th December, 2019 one of the conditions imposed was that the applicant shall report Faujdar Chavdi Police Station, Solapur once in a month on every first Saturday between 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon till further orders.

4 Looking to the nature of accusation and the material placed on record by the prosecution in support of the allegations levelled *qua* the applicant, it would not be proper to relax the said condition, instead, the applicant shall attend Faujdar Chavdi Police Station, Solapur on every first Saturday between 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon once in two months.

5 The applicant shall abide by rest of the conditions.

6 The application is disposed of.
