ORDER:

1. Mentioned out of turn by the learned advocate for the applicant.
2. Learned advocate for the applicant submits that this application is for recalling the conditional order granting time to remove office objections. There is a delay in filing the application.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the reasons for not removing office objections within time are explained in paragraph no.3 of the application. He further submits that inadvertently and due to oversight the objections were not removed

within time. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the office objections shall be removed within three weeks from today.
