1. The Petitioner has prayed for an earlier decision in the Appeal pending before the Chief Executive Officer of Zilla Parishad, Sangli. He draws our attention to the fact that the Second Appeal was filed before the Divisional Commissioner, Pune Division. He prays that the Appeal before the Chief Executive Officer of Zilla Parishad, Sangli, be decided expeditiously. The Petitioner would withdraw the Appeal preferred before the Divisional Commissioner, Pune Division.
