2. By this revision application, the applicant prays for
stay of the orders of conviction dated 03/02/2020 and
01/10/2021 passed by the trial Court and the appellate
Court respectively.

3. The application is opposed by the learned APP. It is
submitted that the sentence imposed by the trial Court is
modified by the appellate Court and only the fine amount

has been directed to be paid. The fine amount has been paid. In such circumstances, learned APP submitted that the impugned order should not be interfered with.
