1. By this Interim Application, the applicant-original petitioner no.3, who is a student pursuing the M.B.B.S. Course in the First Year, seek declaration of results of the examinations that were held in August 2024.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners refers to the order dated 2nd

January 2024 passed by the Supreme Court in Petition for Special Leave to Appeal (C) No.27619/2023 (*Tanmay Rakesh Bhugaonkar Vs. The National Medical Commission and Ors.*). He submits that the supplementary examinations are now scheduled on 16th October 2024. If the Petitioners' results are not declared, they would lose one academic year.

3. Ms. Asha Bhambwani, the learned counsel for the Respondent No.6 – Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik submits to the orders of the Court.

4. Accordingly and subject to the outcome of the Writ Petition, the Respondent No.6 shall declare the results of all the applicant and all the petitioners with regard to the First Year of M.B.B.S. Course that was conducted in August 2024. In case the applicant and all the petitioners are required to appear for the supplementary examination, the College shall accept their forms immediately with late fees. These directions are subject to final outcome of the Writ Petition and the applicant and all the petitioners shall not claim any equity.

5. The Interim Application is disposed of.

6. The parties to act on an authenticated copy of this order.

7. To be heard along with Writ Petition Nos.1499 of 2024 and 1498 of 2024.
