On the other hand, the learned APP strongly opposed the application and pointed out that the offence is very serious and there are eyewitnesses to the incident who have attributed a specific role of the applicant. Moreover, there are antecedents and bloodstained clothes were recovered from the applicant.

5. Having considered the submissions made by both the parties and I have gone through the charge-sheet and the material collected by the IO during the investigation, it is evident that 7 injuries were found on the person of the deceased and he died due to hemorrhagic shock due to stab wound. There is sufficient evidence that the applicant is the author of the said stab wound.

6. In the circumstances, considering the recovery and statement of eyewitnesses, I am not inclined to grant bail. Accordingly, the application is **rejected**.
