The above Appeal challenges the impugned order dated 26th June, 2019 passed by the Family Court, Solapur. By the impugned order, the Petition for divorce filed by the Appellant-husband was dismissed. 4 Accordingly, we dismiss the above Interim Application filed seeking a stay of the impugned order dated 26th June, 2019.
