1. The petitioners have invoked extraordinary constitutional jurisdiction of this Court challenging the order fixing the matter before the Apex Grievance Redressal Committee for order. According to the petitioners, the matter is closed for order without giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

2. If the petitioners are aggrieved by final order of the Apex Grievance Redressal Committee, the petitioners have alternative remedy of challenging final order passed against the petitioners.
