1. Learned counsel for the Applicant on instructions seeks leave to withdraw the Application.

Learned counsel for the Applicant however submits that in spite of order passed by this Court dated 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 in Bail Application No. 3518 of 2022, directing the trial court to conclude the trial as early as possible, there is no progress and the trial is still at the stage of framing of charge.
