- 4) Mr. Kanchan, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner admitted the said fact.
- 5) As far as the visitation rights of child namely Ms. Navya, to the Respondent No. 4 is concerned, Respondent No.4 is at liberty to file appropriate proceedings before the Family Court or in the Civil Court of competent jurisdiction as may be permissible under the law, in that behalf.
- 6) In view of the above, nothing further survives in the Petition and is accordingly disposed off.
