By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of the
impugned Look Out Circular issued by the respondent No.2–Serious
Fraud Investigation Office (SFIO) to the Immigration Authority.

fairly states that after investigation, the SFIO has not found any material to implicate the petitioner as an accused, and, as such have withdrawn the Look Out Notice issued at their behest, as against the petitioner. Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 showed us the communication dated 31st January 2024, addressed to the Commissioner Bureau of Investigating Agency, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, by the Deputy Director of SFIO, withdrawing the Look Out Notice, as against the petitioner.
