1. The Applicant had earlier approached this Court for anticipatory bail vide A.B.A. No.1457/2023. The order dated 6.6.2023 passed by this Court (Coram: Anuja Prabhudesai, J.) records that after arguing the matter for some while, and when it was expressed that this was not a case for granting the relief, learned counsel for the Applicant sought leave to withdraw the application.
