1. The learned counsel for Appellant submits that this Court has released the co-accused on bail and the role attributed to the present Appellant and the said co-accused is identical. It is further submitted that the Appellant is in jail for more than four years.

In that view of the matter, at this stage, I am not inclined to entertain the present Appeal. The trial Court shall endeavour to conclude the trial within a period of 6 months from the date of receipt the copy of
