. It reveals from the record that the suit which is pending before the learned trial Court is of the year 2015. The present Appeal is preferred against the order passed by the learned trial Court rejecting the interim relief. This Appeal can be disposed of by directing the learned trial Court to dispose of the Notice of Motion.
