2 The applicant seeks relaxation of the condition to attend the Crime Branch as directed by this Court in Criminal Bail Application No. 531 of 2014 on 6th May, 2014.

3 It is submitted that out of 400 the prosecution examined 50 witnesses so far. It will take a considerable time to conclude the trial and, therefore, the applicant seeks relaxation of the said condition.
