The Petitioners seek to challenge the order dated 5th June 2004 passed by the Divisional Joint Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Mumbai in Revision Application No. 204 of 2004 relating to a recovery certificate issued by him under Section 101 of the Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act, 1960.
