1. By this application, the claimant seeks leave to withdraw the amount of compensation deposited by the original appellant. We have perused the judgment of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal and we have heard the learned counsel for the parties. Prima facie, considering the nature of injuries suffered by the claimant coupled with the deposition of the Doctor-PW2, we are inclined to permit the claimant to withdraw an amount of Rs. 25,00,000/- subject to outcome of the first appeal. The claimant shall file an undertaking in this Court within a period of eight

weeks from today stating therein that if the award passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal is set aside or the amount of compensation is reduced below Rs. 25,00,000/- he shall deposit the requisite amount in this Court as and when directed by the Court.

2. The Interim application is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
