1) Applicants i.e. husband (Applicant No.1); mother-in-law (Applicant No.2); brother-in-law (Applicant No.3); sister-in-law (Applicant No.4) and father-in-law (Applicant No.5) of Respondent No.3, have filed present Application under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code for quashing of C.C. No. 457/PW/2021 pending on the file of 49th Metropolitan Magistrate, Vikhroli,

Mumbai, arising out of CR No. 315 of 2019 dated 26th May 2019 registered with Vikhroli Police Station, Mumbai, under Sections 498(A), 406, 504, 506 read with 34 of Indian Penal Code (I.P.C.), with the consent of Respondent No.3, the informant.
