2. The applicants (original accused in Sessions Case No.295 of 2019) seek cancellation of non-bailable warrant issued against them by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pune, on 12 February 2024. The learned Counsel for the applicants fairly submits that the applicants are not evading their appearance and intend to be present in the trial court tomorrow, i.e. 17 April 2024, and file a fresh application seeking cancellation of non-bailable warrant.

3. The learned Additional Sessions Judge shall consider the

said application on its own merits and decide the same in accordance with the law. In view of this, the execution and implementation of the order dated 12 February 2024 is stayed upto 23 April 2024.

4. As such, the present criminal application stands disposed of.

5. It is made clear that if occasion so arises, the applicants are at liberty to take appropriate steps in accordance with the law.
