1. By the impugned order, the Sub-Divisional Officer has allowed amendment of the application seeking condonation of delay. It is needless to state that the sufficiency of cause introduced by the amendment will be considered by the Sub-Divisional Officer at the time of deciding application seeking condonation of delay.
