1. After arguing for some time, when I expressed my disinclination to grant relief in this application, the learned counsel for the Applicant prays for unconditional withdrawal of this application.

2. Permission is granted. The application is allowed to be withdrawn.

3. However, learned counsel submitted that this

withdrawal may not come in the way of the Applicant to seek regular bail.

4. The request is reasonable. The application is allowed to be withdrawn unconditionally. If the Applicant makes an application for regular bail, after her arrest or surrender, it shall be decided at the earliest, keeping in mind that the Applicant is a Government employee. The said application shall be decided on its own merits in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

5. With these observations, the application is disposed of.
