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prayer was for setting aside Mutation Entry Nos. 594, 638, 797 and 1027. The appeal was dismissed by the SDO against which the petitioners preferred a revision application before the MRT. Revision application is also dismissed by MRT. Perusal of the record indicates that the proceeding initiated by the petitioners are not under Tenancy Act. However, the same pertain to the challenge to the mutation entry.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has tendered an additional affidavit dated 2nd May 2024 of the petitioners. Additional affidavit explains the status under which proceedings were filed and further seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty to adopt appropriate legal remedy for agitating the grievance of the petitioners in the petition. Additional affidavit is taken on record.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the petitioners are permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to adopt appropriate legal remedy as permissible in law.

5. Writ Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as stated above.

6. Needless to clarify that all contentions of all parties on merits are kept open.
