1. The Applicant had earlier approached this Court by way of Anticipatory Bail Application No.535 of 2024. In that case, the following order was passed on 05/03/2024 :

“1. After arguing for some time, when I expressed my disinclination to grant relief in this application, the learned counsel for the Applicant prays for unconditional withdrawal of this application.

2. *Permission is granted. The application is allowed to be withdrawn unconditionally and is disposed of as such.”*

2. After that, within a short time, the present application is filed without there being any change in circumstance. There is sanctity attached to the submissions made before the Court and the prayers made before the Court. On the previous occasion, after the arguments, the application was allowed to be withdrawn on the prayer made by the Applicant’s counsel.

3. In this view of the matter, I am not inclined to entertain this application. The application is accordingly dismissed.
