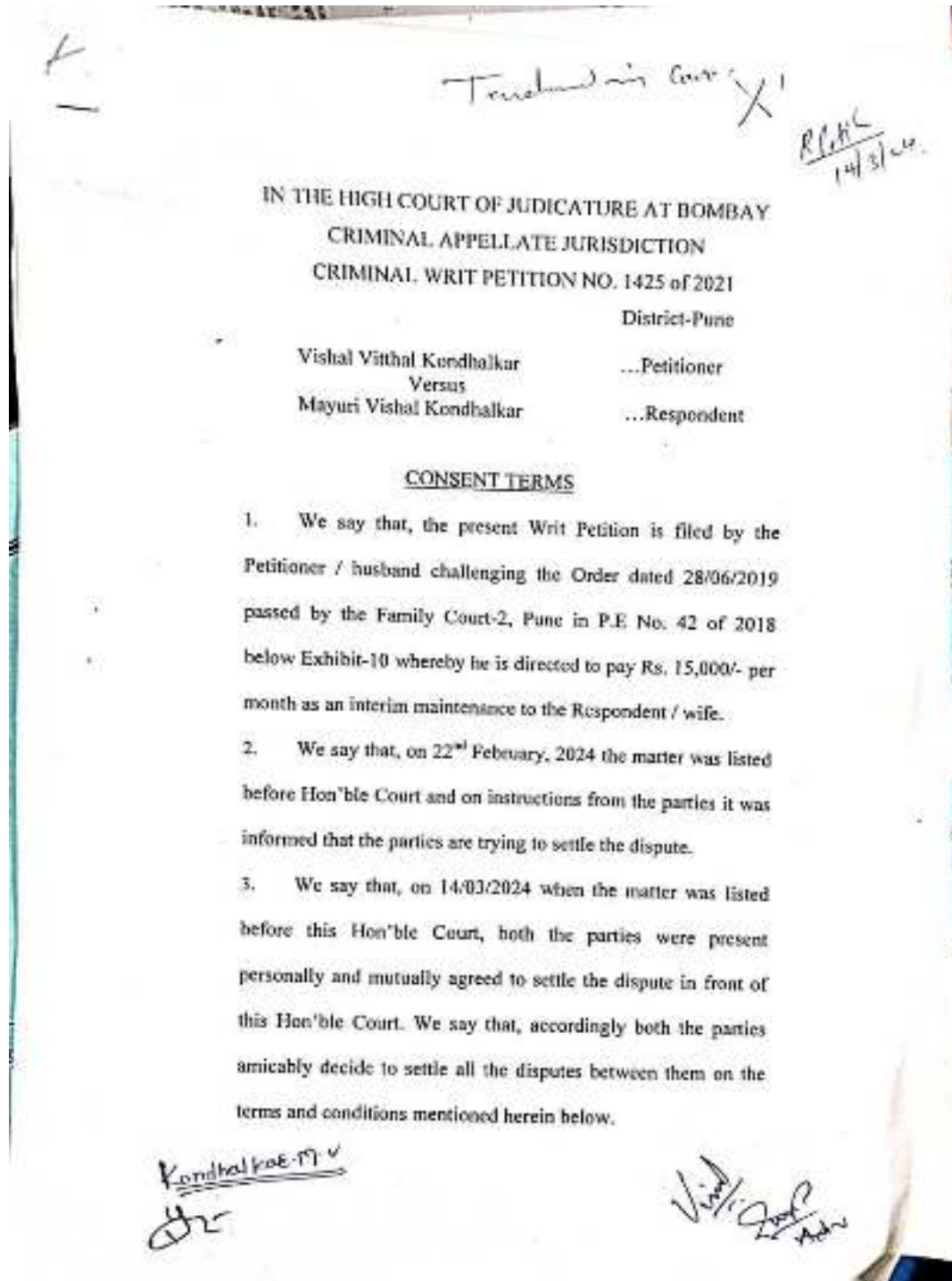

- A. We say that, the Petitioner hereby agreed to pay the Respondent / Wife an amount of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs Only) in three instalments.
- B. We say that, the Petitioner hereby agreed to pay Rs.3,00,000/- (in words Three Lakhs only) on or before 18th March, 2024. Further Rs. 4,00,000/- (in words Four Lakhs only) on or before 26th April, 2024. The Petitioner further agree to pay an amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- (in words Three Lakhs only) on or before 10th June, 2024 to the Respondent / wife. All the three payments will be made by way of Demand Draft in the name of "Mayuri Vilas Pawar" (which is maiden name of Respondent).
- C. We say that, after payment of the entire amount, both the parties will withdraw all the proceedings filed against each other on the basis of present consent term.
- D. After payment of entire amount of Rs. 10,00,000/- (in words Ten Lakhs only) both the parties will remain present before Family Court, Pune on 18/06/2024 for Divorce proceedings on the ground of mutual consent.

F. We say that whatever is stated hereinabove is true and correct to the best of my own knowledge and I believe the same to be true.

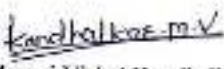
4. The Petitioner and Respondent have arrived at these consent terms at their own free will, being of sound mind, without any force, pressure or undue influence.
