2. After perusing the impugned order dated 06.07.2022, I have expressed my mind to Mr. Khude, and after taking instructions from Petitioners he would submit that the Writ Petition be allowed to be withdrawn.

3. He would make a request that this Court be pleased to pass appropriate directions for expeditious hearing of the suit by the learned Civil Court.
