1. Heard Mr. Barsawade, learned Counsel for the applicant.

Learned Counsel for the applicant seeks restoration of Bail Application bearing No.881 of 2022 which came to be dismissed for non prosecution by this Court (Coram: Shivkumar Dige, J.) on 29th August, 2023.
