Mr. Bhavesh Wadhwani, learned counsel appearing for M.V.Kini & Co. for the bank informs this Court that these petitions have now become infructuous as the matters have been settled before the National Lok Adalat on 7 July, 2022. He has handed over a photocopy of the order dated 7 July, 2022. The said order dated 7 July, 2022 passed by the National Lok Adalat is taken on record and marked 'X' for identification.
