

Consent Terms, the complainant has no objection for quashing the impugned proceedings.

3. Respondent no.2 has also filed affidavit dated 22nd January 2024 stating that matrimonial discord between Respondent no.2/ complainant and Applicants has been resolved amicably and they have jointly filed Consent Terms in the proceedings under Domestic Violence Act. Respondent no.2 is present in the Court. She has admitted the contents of affidavit and consent terms. She has expressed her no objection for quashing the proceedings.

4. Considering the fact that parties have amicably settled the dispute, the prayers sought in the application can be granted.

ORDER

- (i) Criminal Application is allowed and disposed off;
- (ii) The proceedings in R.C.C No.1123 of 2023 pending before 4th Joint Civil Judge and Judicial Magistrate First Class, Thane arising out of FIR No.551 of 2022 registered with Kashimira Police Station, District Thane, are quashed and set aside.
