1. Not on board. Upon mentioning, taken on production board.
2. Civil application has been preferred seeking stay to the execution of judgment and award dated 30<sup>th</sup> March 2017 passed in LAR No. 97 of 2009. Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant submits that entire decretal amount along with accrued interest has already been deposited in the Reference Court. She would further submit that application has been moved by the Respondent-Claimants for withdrawal of the compensation amount without furnishing any security.
3. Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on **6<sup>th</sup> December**

**2024.** In addition to the Court notice, learned counsel appearing for the Appellant to serve the Respondents by private notice by all possible modes of service and file affidavit of service before the next date.

**5.** Till the next date, there shall be ad-interim relief in terms of prayer Clause (a).

**6.** This Court is informed that the amount which was deposited was calculated upto 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023. Let the balance amount be deposited in the Reference Court within four weeks from today.
