- 1) Both the parties are present before the Court and they are identified by their counsels.

- 2) They have arrived at settlement. Accordingly, Consent Letters-cum-Consent Terms of the Appellant-Husband and the Respondent-Wife are taken on record and marked 'X' and 'X-1' respectively. Accordingly, Appellant/Husband along

with his father undertake to withdraw the proceeding bearing Suit No.253 of 2020 pending before the City Civil Court at Greater Bombay.

3) The Respondent/wife also undertakes to withdraw the case filed by her in the Family Court at Bandra, Mumbai bearing no. E-202 of 2023.

4) Both the parties have agreed to apply for divorce by mutual consent in the Family Court at Bandra on the aforesaid terms. The Respondent-Wife has waived permanent alimony and maintenance for herself from the Appellant.

5) In view of the aforesaid settlement, the Appellant-Husband seeks leave to withdraw the Appeal. Leave granted.

6) The Family Court Appeal is disposed as withdrawn.
