. Writ Petition No. 14576 of 2018 with connected writ petitions filed by the Petitioners were disposed of on 27 March 2023 by the following order:

“10. In light of the above discussion, we pass the following order:

- (i) The impugned order to the extent of recovery is quashed and set aside.*
- (ii) The order with regard to re-pay fixation done is not interfered with.*
- (iii) The amount, if recovered from the petitioners, shall be refunded to them within 4 (four) months.”*

2 Learned counsel for the Petitioners states that clause (iii) of the order dated 27 March 2023 is not complied with by the Zilla Parishad.

3. Leave is granted to join Zilla Parishad, Thane as party Respondent. Amendment to be carried out during the course of the day.

4. Issue notice before admission to the added Respondent, returnable on **23 April 2024** so that if the order as above is not complied with, the remedial action can be taken by the added Respondent, failing which, Court may proceed under the contempt jurisdiction.

5. In addition to Court notice, Petitioners are permitted to serve private notice through Registered Post A.D. / Speed Post / E-mail and file affidavit of service before the returnable date.
