1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. Dr Kantawala, based on instructions from the Petitioners whose Directors are present in the Court today, seeks leave to withdraw this Petition with liberty to institute two Appeals against the impugned orders. He states that such Appeals will be instituted within four weeks from today.
