After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, we find that on 01/08/2024 the Authority under Rule 8 of the Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act 2012 has informed the petitioner that the report submitted by the petitioner dated 29/12/2022 indicating the condition of the school building is valid for a duration of only one year. The petitioner has thus been called upon to submit a structural audit report indicating its fitness for about fifteen to twenty years.
