ORDER :-

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner-husband on instructions of the petitioner who is present in the court states that he is agreeable to explore the possibility of settlement.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent-wife submits on instructions that respondent is also agreeable to explore the

possibility of settlement. However, he submits that the arrears towards the interim maintenance are to the tune of Rs.1,37,000/-.
