Since an alternate/efficient remedy of preferring an appeal under Rule 82 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue (Extraction and Removal of Minor Minerals) Rules, 2013 is available for challenging the order dated 06/03/2024, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the writ petition with a further liberty to avail such remedy.
