1. The existence of the Mutation Entry, is the consequent effect, depending upon the result of the challenge to the consolidation scheme. The challenge to the scheme, has been permitted to be raised by condoning the delay by the order of this Court dated 13.04.2023 in WP No. 4332 of 2022 (page 131). The grievance therefore to the amendment permitting the challenge to the Mutation Entry is therefore without any merit

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for the reason that the Mutation Entry is a consequence of the sanction of the scheme and would be a consequential relief.

2. The Petition is therefore dismissed. No order as to costs.
