1. By the present petition, the challenge is to order arising out of issuance of Recovery Certificate.
2. Learned counsel for Petitioner, on instructions, submits that subsequently the matter had been settled with Respondent No.2-Path Sanstha and 'No Dues Certificate' has been obtained. The copy of 'No Dues Certificate' is tendered by Path Sanstha and the same is taken on record.
